This course is for Stage 6 teachers of Biology, Chemistry, Earth and Environmental Science and Investigating Science.

Participants will:

- gain an understanding of key Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander knowledge outcomes from the various Stage 6 Science syllabus documents.
- engage in a hands-on practical session based on traditional Aboriginal activities that can be embedded into Stage 6 teaching and learning programs.
- develop their knowledge and confidence to embed activities that incorporate Aboriginal science and cultural themes into their Stage 6 teaching and learning programs.
