Friday 29 May 2020

The 'Leadership in Aboriginal Education' conference is designed for experienced teachers and school leaders K-12. This conference empowers teachers to empathise, ideate, innovate and implement strategies to inspire colleagues to make a difference for the Aboriginal children in their schools.

Friday 24 July 2020

The ASA Teacher Conference is a great opportunity for experienced and new Aboriginal Studies teachers and K-6 teachers to participate in a number of professional learning workshops and keynote lectures. These are led by experienced Aboriginal Studies teachers and prominent speakers in the field to further develop skills and knowledge in this critical area of education.

The ASA Student Conference for HSC students provides a number of workshops led by experienced Aboriginal Studies teachers. Workshops include tips and preparation for Major Projects, maximising marks in the HSC, how to consult with Aboriginal communities and other aspects of the HSC course. Students will take away resources to guide them through to the HSC.

Friday 20 November 2020

We present a Masterclass building on previous teacher and executive K-12 professional learning experiences. Here, critical thinking and reflection is mobilised to develop culturally responsive leadership skills in Aboriginal education contexts and, specifically, in your school context.
